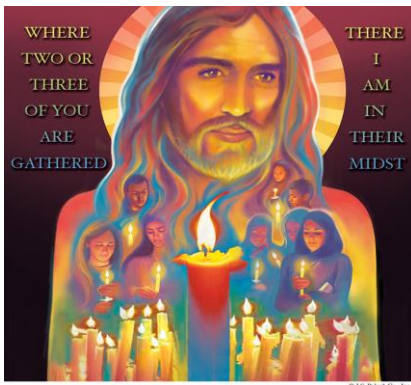
How, at times, do you shirk that cross when it is not convenient?
