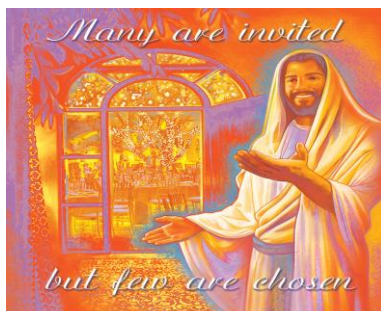
A Stewardship Moment
